HISTORIC ROYAL PALACES

THE CENTRAL BED IN THIS GARDEN is planted with the Northern Ireland Centenary Rose. It was commissioned by the Northern Ireland Office from Dickson's Nurseries in Newtownards and is a cross between their "Storyteller", and a Kordes rose called "Moment in Time". A pleasantly scented Floribunda with soft pink, ivory and pale yellow semi-double blooms, this rose flowers profusely all season.
