AN INTRODUCTION TO TECHNOLOGY

This is a basic introduction to technology and will consist of things you need to know and some things you don't need to know, but are included for interest only. Everybody must start somewhere, and the beginning is often the best place.

The objective of this course is to simplify the language of technology and try to explain 'Tech Jargon' in a way that is easy to understand using comparisons between the computer and the everyday life events that we all experience. If we understand the terminology used by computers, we take away the fear of them.

The course will cover subjects such as;

- A brief introduction to the Microprocessor.
- Methods we use to communicate with computers and how they communicate with us.
- Different types of memory, where they are used and what they are used for.
- Storage devices, hard drives, memory cards, pen drives.
- What are the common 'computer programs' and how do we use them.
- Some things we should be cautious of, data loss, scams, computer viruses and how to avoid them.

This all sounds very complicated, but remember, we are only learning the words; we're not going to build a computer!

Reminders:
