BOOK GROUP 1

We met on 2nd March at a member's home to discuss Louise Kennedy's first novel Trespasses. which was set in Northern Ireland in the mid 1970's. We all agreed that the background to the love story was very accurate. Some members did not like returning to that time as many had their own sometimes harrowing memories of those times. This accurate portrayal of the time led to a few members not enjoying the book at all. There was much discussion about the trespasses of the books title. The love story was about Michael, an older Protestant and upper-class barrister, and Cushla, a younger publican's daughter and a primary school teacher. The narration felt real with authentic characters.

For April's meeting we are reading The Lincoln Highway by Amor Towles.

May's read is The Dark Tourist by Dom Joly.

BOOK GROUP 2

Our April meeting is at 10.30 am on Tuesday 25th when our book is 'Middle England' by Jonathan Coe (pub.2019). A 'State of the Nation Novel' from a writer regarded as the best chronicler of modern England whose underlying preoccupations are with political issues and the conflict between his native Midlands and the metropolitan elitism of the South. The book centres on the Brexit Referendum and its aftermath. The clinical dissection of events and people is often comically expressed, revealing both deep sadness and sweet memories through a random cast of characters. Ultimately this is a book about people and why they act as they do.
